CRICKET SEASON REVIEW

In season 2011-12 the Club was proud to field 4 senior teams in A, B, C and D grades as well entering a Vets Team (over 40's) in the HDCA.

In the HDCA junior competition, Banyule was proud to field 8 junior teams in season 2011-12, (U17's x2, U15s x2, U13's x2 and U11's x2)

The club also ran another very successful Milo In2Cricket Program (ages 5-9).

We are very pleased that the club's subsequent application was met enthusiastically by both the DVCA executive and its clubs, in recognition of Banyule's reputation as a strong and stable community club. 2012-13 will bring new challenges of course in a new competition, but the club should look forward to these new opportunities with excitement.

It was fantastic to see the club's new 5 pitch practice net facility open for business last season which should improve the quality of training and skill development opportunities significantly. The club's facilities, on and off the field, remain at the highest standards available in suburban cricket.

Well done to all the committee for your work through the year but especially President - Mick Asbury, Treasurer – Darren Butterworth and Junior Manager – Geoff Place. TREASURERS REPORT & FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

TO THE MEMBERS OF THE BANYULE CRICKET CLUB INC.

The final result for the year ended 30 April 2012 was a surplus of \$105. This is a solid result for the season highlighted by the following:

- Fundraising provided some thoroughly entertaining events, a great time was had by all. On the financial front we made solid profit on the comedy night and the cocktail party.
- Balls were again a significant cost to the club with \$3,688 being spent on match day and practice balls, this was consistent with last season.
- Utilities were again a major expenditure. With the size of the rooms and the frequency of the usage \$7,072 was spent, the majority of this being for electricity. Electricity increased 50% on last season.
- Membership levels remained constant from last season.
- Sponsorship continues to be a major source of income to the club. However this season saw a significant reduction on previous seasons, we need to regain or replace the major sponsors we have lost to maintain the viability of the club. The total takings for sponsorship was \$8,431. Player sponsors have reduced to only a handful, another area we need to work on.
- Bar turnover was again lower than previous seasons due to the amount of washouts, but still maintained a 42% margin, consistent with previous seasons. The introduction of the free drinks for early membership payment and some issues we had with the bar equipment reduced the margin slightly.
- As with the last few seasons the club has spent significant amount on improvements to the clubs facilities. These include a bowling machine and the nets.

The budget for the 2012/12 season was for a profit of \$1,125. We are well under this for the season but given the amount of wash outs and the improvements we have made to the club it is a fantastic result.

The club is now able to provide it's members with top quality facilities for playing, training and socially which will improve the clubs position both on and off the field in the years to come.

Again special mentions to the various helpers out there that make my job a little easier.

Thanks to Pidge for his assistance and collecting monies on Thursdays and Saturdays. Thanks to Johno for his work in the sponsorship area, the new package looks great! Thanks to Doc for his social organisation this season, our events were fantastic and we managed to make some good profit on some of the events which is a bonus. Thanks to Tommy for his work organising the bar, may have been more work then he expected but he did a great job taking over from Mumbles. Philo continue's to do a power of work for our club, the association and various others. Thanks Philo for your valuable input throughout the season. Thanks to the rest of the committee for their various assistance this year. Lastly on the club front a huge thanks to Mick for his support. He does a great job as president, although as I said last year he needs help from others. Too many people take for granted the amount of work that goes in to running the club in the background, without people like Mick and Philo the club would grind to a halt. It's time for some one else out there to stand up and take on some responsibility for our great club!

Lastly I would like to thank Kym for her support this season. Between being at the club and meetings to having a spare room filled with receipts and invoices it does take away a fair chunk of our family time. Your understanding and support is very much appreciated.

Looking forward to an exciting new chapter in the clubs history both on and off the field in the DVCA!

CAPTAIN'S REPORT

Once again I was honoured to be asked to captain the Second Grade, after what I felt was a positive season in 2010/11, but unfortunately this did not flow into the 2011/12 season. The season was a challenging one, for which we were not able to win a game throughout and this translated into our second grade finishing last on the ladder.

The biggest hurdle that had to be crossed as a team was to maintain the same structure from week to week, as throughout the season we used 32 players across the 13 games completed (one game was washed out). The highlights one of the major issues that, whilst wasn't the only one, but certainly created a major hindrance to get the season rolling in the right direction. When looking at those who represented the 2nd grade, and whilst appreciative of all those who played, one of the most damning factors were that of the 32, only 3 players made their 2nd grade debut.

When reviewing the overall season statistics, which is a fair indication of the 'churn' we had within the team, only 4 batsman had an aggregate that was over 100 runs and only 5 bowlers had a season aggregate of more than 10 wickets. Further to this, only 3 batsmen made half centuries and only one bowler took 5 wickets or more in an innings.

Within most of the game throughout the season, we were eventually outplayed by the opposition, as a group we were definitely competitive throughout parts of the game, but weren't able to maintain the momentum that is necessary to become a successful side. The next stage of the development for the key players 25 years old and under is to understand how to read the game and know when to maintain the positive momentum when we have the upper hand, but also how to 'dig in' for the hard yards when it is going against us.

Some of the games to note that as a group were some of the better efforts were:

Round 1 (vs. Edinburgh – Away) Coming in against last year's Division 2 Premiers with a young side we were extremely competitive throughout the 1-day game making 6/105 (40 over's) batting first on an extremely lush outfield, to then make them fight until the 39th over to pass our score. Two standouts in this game were James Alexandrov (3/19 off 8 over's) and Michael Delaney (32).

Round 3 (vs. Rosanna – Away) After restricting Rosanna to 8/125 (36 over's) on a rain shortened game, and then being 4/5, we were able to fight back and fall just 5 runs short in the last over prior to being bowled out. Standouts in this game was Luke Delaney (3/18 off 7 over's) and Daine Watts (52).

Round 9 (vs. Old Ivanhoe – Home) After Old Ivanhoe were able to make 7/190 off their 40 over's after being 3/105 after 20, and then it came down to the last few over's for which we fell 15 runs short with a wicket still in hand. Standouts were Pat Lunn (2/26 off 8 over's) and Will Barnes (61).

A couple of individuals I'd like to call out in this report are:

Will Barnes: Will debuted in the 1st Round as our wicketkeeper, whilst batting down the lower orders. After showing that his abilities behind the stumps were certainly of a high standard, and signs of development with the bat, he was promoted to the # 3 position through opportunities opening up, he was able to display via both various individual performances and displaying a mature temperament, that through further coaching and development he will become an important all-round cricketer for the future success of the cricket club.

Corey Parrant: Corey has been playing senior cricket for a couple of seasons, but due to injuries has not been able to display his talent on the park consistently, but certainly throughout the 2011/12 season he was able to show glimpses. None more so in an early season game where he took 6/23 against North Brunswick/Rosebank in what was a devastating spell of bowling for which through pure pace and the ability to swing the ball was simply far too good for some senior batsman playing on the opposition. Once again, with further coaching and development, he will become a strong pillar within the success of the Banyule Bears cricket club in the future.

In what was a challenging year personally for myself from a work perspective, where my ability to attend Thursday night training and therefore selection nights were severely inhibited, I'd like to thank Mick Asbury, Steve Pinner and Les Dahl in providing such strong support throughout.

As a team and as a club we have a good, strong base of cricketers who love the club. Each of us involved within know how to do each of the 3 disciplines of cricket in batting, bowling and fielding, to the best of their given abilities, but what we need within the club, but even more so within the 2nd Grade, is the hungriness and will to want to win. The want to win is best displayed when you take it upon yourself to do everything you can to ensure you give 100% to the team, and don't

leave it up to someone else to do it. That doesn't necessarily take the key wicket, or hit a boundary, but to either maintain or regain the momentum that is a part of every game of cricket.
